- It is expected that each piece of work is made by the artist. Items must conform to one of the following: Michigan made, Detroit themed, related to French or Native American heritage.
- Applications are due by July 1, 2019.
- Send the \$30 donation (check made out to Ste. Anne de Detroit) with application.
   Donation will be refunded if your application is not accepted. Vendor cancellations of accepted applications received by July 1 will receive a 100% refund. No refunds made after July 1.
- Each space will be  $10'\times10'$ . Vendors/Artists provide own tables, tent and chairs. No electric hook up is available.
- Each artist is asked to contribute one item for the basket raffle to benefit Ste.

  Anne de Detroit. See separate donation form.
- Set up may begin at 9:00 a.m. and must be completed by 11:00 a.m. Vendors may pull in between the school and church buildings where they will be directed to their site. After unloading at site vehicles are to be taken immediately to artist parking area before booths are set up.
- Free admission to this event is limited to the artist/vendor listed on the application and one assistant.
