- Tours are arranged for groups larger than 10 persons. For groups with fewer than 10 persons, call the office and we will arrange that you are added to a larger tour group.
- Groups are granted a 15-minute leeway from the agreed-upon time. Arrivals after 15 minutes are subject to cancellation. Please be prompt in your arrival.
- Ste. Anne is unable to accommodate drop-ins, please call at least two weeks in advance to ensure that a docent will be available for your group.
