I am very excited to announce that our parish's signature summer event, Novena, will take place this year from July 17 - 26. This joyful event is a decades-old tradition at the Basilica of Ste. Anne de Detroit. Novena is nine days of prayer including a noon Mass and an evening Mass. Each day of prayer has a different theme associated with an ethnic group important to Detroit. On the tenth day, we celebrate the Feast of Ste. Anne. We gather to ask Ste. Anne to pray for our intentions, the intentions of our families, our city, our Archdiocese, and our world.

Masses will be in person and livestreamed. We also plan to offer celebrations outdoors on the plaza after each Mass. A schedule is enclosed.

We are offering our friends and parishioners a chance to support the Basilica of Ste. Anne by making a donation for our Novena Celebration Program. This program book will be given to everyone who attends Novena and will also be available online.

The book is comprehensive and will be used on all ten days of the celebration. There are three ways to show your support.
